

What we will explore through the reading:

We will be reading a range of books over the term and completing various foundation subject activities linked to them.

This term we will be learning:

English: word classes, including verbs and adverbs, nouns and adjectives and conjunctions and prepositions. We will be writing a suspense narrative and a persuasive letter. We will cover direct and indirect speech linked to the Iron Man novel.

Mathematics: multiplication and division, measurement: money, length and perimeter, and number fractions.

Science: magnets and forces.

Homework, including, on-line, termly projects and ideas to support your children

- **Reading:** children will be reading on a daily basis and be able to take a library book home each week. Your child will be expected to read at home daily, either to you, an older sibling or independently. We actively encourage you to discuss your child's story with them. We would also like to know your child is trying to learn new vocabulary frequently.
- **Mathematics:** your child should also be learning the first twelve facts of the 3, 4 and 8 times tables, including revising the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. You may use mathletics to help revise work done in school. Practising times tables will have a lasting benefit to your child's learning.
- **Spellings:** new spellings or handwriting activities are given out each week and tests are on a Friday.
