What we will explore through the reading:

In English, we will be reading the novel, *Starspill* by Catherine Fisher during our morning reading sessions as well as exploring a range of poetry, fiction and non-fiction. In Creative Curriculum, our reading will mainly link to our philosophical question, where we will explore texts about inspirational people who have inspired others and changed our world for the better, particularly with regard to the Global Goals.

What we are covering this term:

English: we will be creating a toolkit for an adventure narrative and writing our own adventure as well as studying the short film, 'The Dream Giver', writing setting and character descriptions, a persuasive letter, a balanced debate and a newspaper article. We will be learning how to use relative clauses effectively and how to punctuate speech.

Maths: area, fractions, decimals, multiplication and division.

We will continue to learn all times table facts.

Creative Curriculum:

Science – classification and biomes.

Geography - how human activity can impact the weather, climate zones and biomes.

Consistent regular reading develops a larger vocabulary and broader knowledge base, fostering curiosity and critical thinking. Additionally, regular reading enhances academic performance, boosts confidence, and promotes empathy, open-mindedness, and social skills by exposing readers to diverse perspectives and cultures.
- In addition to reading and times tables homework, the children can access Mathletics, Times Table Rock Stars and Purple Mash online at any time. They should have a copy of their login details for each educational website. If these have been lost, please ask for a replacement.
