#### Our ELG targets for this term:

**Reading**: to read and understand simple sentences, to use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and to read them aloud accurately, to also read some common irregular words, to demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.

**Writing**: to use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds, to also write some irregular common words, to write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others (some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible).

Mathematics and Shape, Space, Measure: to count reliably with numbers from 1 - 20, to place them in order and to say which number is 1 more or 1 less than a given number, to use quantities and objects to add and subtract 2 single digit numbers, to count on or back to find the answer, to solve problems including doubling, halving and sharing, to use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and to solve problems, to explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and to use mathematical language to describe them.
