What we are covering this term:

English: We will be reading and writing non-fiction texts, including explanations and non chronological reports. We will be writing our own stories following Talk for Writing techniques. Our main focus is reading with understanding and comprehension skills in preparation for SATs.

Maths: Reading and writing numbers up to 1000, fractions, place value, statistics, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division facts.

Money, shape, weight, capacity, time and real life problems.

Science: Materials, animals including humans, keeping healthy and habitats.

Our topics are: Is The North East the Best Place to Live?

We will investigate maps, landmarks, sculptures and local historical heroes during this topic. We will also listen to, and learn, local songs. As part of work, we will investigate materials to see which one would be most suitable to build a new bridge.

How did the Great Fire change London?

During this topic we will sequence the events of the Great Fire. We will also compare Newcastle to London and explore buildings and materials, as well as looking at Samuel Pepys' diary.
