



FREE cycle training Easter Holidays

Following on from the popularity of our school holiday events, Newcastle City Council Road Safety will be holding 6 days of FREE cycle training at The Walker Activity Dome this Easter. The two-hour training sessions will be available to Adults and children from 6 years who live, work or attend school in Newcastle upon Tyne, and is free of charge to participants. Children must be accompanied by an adult. All training is delivered by qualified National Standard Instructors who have DBS checks. The below courses will be offered:

Learn to ride is suitable for complete beginners and will be tailored to the ability and pace of the trainees.

Level 1 Bikeability is aimed at those who can set off, pedal and stop. The course focuses on perfecting bike handling skills such as stopping in control, using gears, signalling, etc.

Level 2 Bikeability is aimed at those who are competent cyclists off road but are keen to develop their riding skills on road. Trainees will develop the skills to ride safely in live traffic and for day to day journeys on quiet roads.

Level 3 Bikeability is aimed at those who are competent cyclists who regularly ride on the road and in live traffic but are keen to develop their riding skills in busier traffic environments and for the day to day cycling commute.
