What we are covering this term:

English: Newspaper reports, diary entries, traditional tales, explanation texts, non-chronological reports and poetry.

Maths: Place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, length and fractions.

Science: Plants, pollination, seed dispersal and magnets.

Creative Curriculum: What Makes An Everyday Hero?

We will be investigating the features of superheroes and reading texts based around the topic. We will search for real-life superheroes and discuss why they are special. The children will be encouraged to think of their own superhero and complete explanations about their creation.

Creative Curriculum: Who is really to blame?

In the second half of the term, we will investigate Traditional Tales in detail. We will link learning about animals, habitats and diets to our work. Our main creative curriculum focus will be on rainforests. The children will also create their own shelters for characters from Traditional Tales.
