*Some homework is presented as project-based as a link with the Creative Curriculum, and therefore not given on a weekly basis. Children are given a longer period of time to complete, and are not expected to be given it on a weekly basis – Y4,Y5 & Y6

**Anti-bullying coordinator will again deliver workshops to each class and parents to challenge perceptions – which can, at times, be unrealistic or incorrect. Some children felt that Y6 monitors in not allowing them access to the building during lunch time was evidence of bad behaviour

EYFS completed questionnaires either 1:1 or as a group. All are happy and enjoy many aspects of school. Some of the comments included: they like playing outside, playing with their teachers, breakfast club, the writing table. They can look at their badges to see their targets, but are unsure what they may change. Except that some said they would like more bikes, glitter pens and dressing-up clothes.
