Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may be aware, in accordance with government guidelines, we are unable to authorise any request for children to miss school due to holidays or extended leave. Once your leave of absence form is competed, and the request submitted, a decision whether or not to issue a penalty notice will be made. Families may be fined £60 per parent, per child, as a result of children missing education.

One of the main reasons children have poor attendance is due to extended holidays taken during term time.

Last year, 1128 days of education were lost at Wingrove. So far this year, in ten days, 43 pupils have contributed to 140 days of unauthorised absence.

Our target for attendance is 95%. It is currently 87.6%. We must work hard to achieve our goal.

"Missing out on lessons leaves children vulnerable to falling behind. Children with poor attendance tend to achieve less in both primary and secondary school" Department of Education 2013.

Please think wisely when booking to go away and try not to take trips during term time. School is only open to children 190 days each year.
