

Elmer the Patchwork Elephant School's design competition

The competition

1. The design competition is open to all school pupils in the Tyne and Wear region aged between 4 and 11 years old.
2. To enter the competition, pupils should design their own Elmer the Patchwork Elephant in their favourite place using the template provided.
3. Entries should be sent to metrovip@nexus.org.uk quoting 'Elmer the Patchwork Elephant School's design competition' in the subject line, or by post to Metro Marketing Department, Metro Control Centre, South Gosforth, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE3 1YT, along with your contact details.
4. You are responsible for any cost incurred in sending your competition entry to us.
5. All entries must include the entrant's name, age, school and school year. We will only use this information in relation to the competition (including checking your eligibility to enter and informing the winners) and will not use it for any other purposes whatsoever. We will not keep this information longer than is necessary for the operation of the competition.
6. All entries must be submitted by the school on behalf of their pupil(s).
7. Only one entry per pupil.
8. We must receive your pupils entries by no later than Monday 3 June 2019. Submissions received after the deadline will not be eligible for entry.

Picking the winner

1. There will be 16 winners, chosen by Tyne and Wear Metro and a representative from St Oswald's Hospice.
2. The decision will be made on or before Monday 17 June 2019. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
3. The winning entries will be displayed on a Metro carriage between July and October 2019.
4. The winning designs will be displayed along with the pupil's name, age and school and school year.
5. Winning entries may be shared by Tyne and Wear Metro and St Oswald's via their social media channels.
6. Schools will only be notified if their pupil's entries have been successful in the competition.

Publishing the entries

1. The names of the winners will be published on the Tyne and Wear Metro website, social media channels and in the local media, on or after 24 June 2019.
2. By submitting an entry to the competition, entrants give Tyne and Wear Metro permission for their entry to be published and grant Tyne and Wear Metro a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide license to republish your competition entry in electronic format and hard copy for purposes connected with the competition.
3. By submitting an entry to the competition, entrants give Tyne and Wear Metro the right to use pupil's name, age and school name and year for the sole purpose of identifying you as the author of your entry.
4. By submitting an entry to the competition, the winners agree to take part in media and PR activity for Tyne and Wear Metro for the purposes of publicising the competition. This includes, but is not limited to press releases and photography.

Getting consent from an adult

1. Sending in an entry to the competition means that you accept these Terms and Conditions, which are the rules of the competition. Schools must check with pupil's parent or guardian that they are happy to grant permission for each pupil to enter the competition based on these Terms and Conditions.
2. Tyne and Wear Metro requires the consent in writing given on the template provided of the parent or guardian of the creator of a winning entry to publish the author's name, age, school and school year and for photography connected to the competition.
3. If Tyne and Wear Metro does not receive written consent via the template provided from the parent or guardian of the creator of a winning entry then we may award the prize to another entry for which we are able to gain such consent.

The prize

1. The winners will see their designs on display in a Metro carriage.
2. The schools of the winners will be notified by telephone or e-mail on or after 24 June 2019.
3. The prize cannot be exchanged or transferred and cannot be redeemed for cash or any other prizes.
4. Each winner will receive a copy of their design before 18 October 2019, sent directly to their school.

Additional terms and conditions

1. Joint submissions are not allowed.
2. We take no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt.
3. Entries will not be returned to you.
4. Tyne and Wear Metro accepts no responsibility for any damages, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered by you as a result of entering the competition or accepting the prize. Tyne and Wear Metro further disclaims liability for any injury or damage to you or any other person's computer relating to or resulting from participation in or downloading any materials in connection with the competition.
