What we are covering this term:

English: We will be reading stories from familiar settings, poetry and non-fiction texts. We will be sequencing and writing sentences, writing instructions and poetry with rhyming patterns. We will also be doing a lot of drama and role-play This term.

Maths: We will be learning to count to and beyond 100. We will also study place value, addition and subtraction facts, money, shape, time and real life problems. We will be including Active Maths and work on the computer too.

Creative Curriculum: This half term, we will be Investigating the question, How Do the Seas Change? In the second half term, we will be looking at Are All Dragons Evil?
