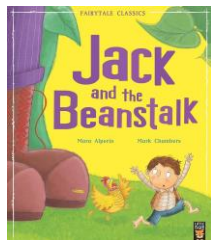
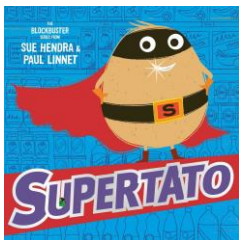

What we will explore through the reading:

We will explore our topics through story, circle time, role play, art and crafts, both inside and outside and during Forest School. We will be thinking about everyday superheroes, planting different seeds and finding out what we need to help plants grow.

This term we will be learning:

Reading/Comprehension: to say a sound for each letter of the alphabet and at least 10 digraphs; to read words consistently by sound-blending and to read simple sentences and books. To understand what has been read to them by retelling stories; anticipate key events in stories and to use and understand new vocabulary.

Writing: to write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed; spell words by identifying the sounds in them and representing with a letter or letters and to write simple phrases or sentences that can be read by others.

Number and pattern: to have a deep understanding of numbers to 10, including the composition of each number; to subitise up to 5 and automatically recall number bonds up to 5 and some to 10, including double facts.

To count beyond 20, recognising patterns; to compare quantities up to 10, recognising when one is greater than, less than or the same as the other. To explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including odds and evens, doubles and how quantities can be shared equally.
