The outcomes of the survey conducted by governors during parents' evenings in November 2018 show an overwhelmingly positive response to the thirteen statements. There are however ten parents who feel their child is not given enough homework. Most of these were from parents of children in Key Stage Two. All children are given weekly spellings, maths, English and reading work to complete, as stated in the Homework Policy and in Year Group newsletters. However, in Key Stage Two some homework is given as a topic and is linked to the Creative Curricular theme. Children are given a longer time to complete these and it may therefore seem that children are not being given homework on a weekly basis.
