## Progress Measures

Due to changes in the tests this year, progress has been measured in a different way. This is because we are no longer working with levels. We are extremely pleased with our progress measures for all children from Y2 to Y6 as they are all in line with the national measures. The scores are as follows (confidence intervals are in brackets):

Reading 1.9 (0.2 to 3.6)

Writing -0.7 (-2.4 to 1.0)

Maths 4.1 (2.7 to 5.5)
