What we are covering this term:

Literacy

This term we will be encouraging the children to become more independent in our reading and writing of Poetry, Fiction and Non-fiction texts.

Our main focus is to write poems and stories using simple writing frames .We will also be writing recounts of visits made.

Numeracy

Counting within 100 and in steps of 2, 5 and 10 both backwards and forwards. Using our understanding of place value, and describing how problems are solved. Using money, shape, and weight in real life situations. Fractions. Division.

Science: Finding out all about **growing things**, and the conditions needed for growth.

Other subjects: This term we are concentrating on learning about different countries and places in Our World. Could you talk to your children about places that you have visited or plan to visit with them? In the second half of the term we will be learning about The Circus.
