COVID 19 Information for Visitors and Volunteers

We look forward to welcoming you to Wingrove Primary School. To ensure that you, our staff and our students are safe we have a number of measures in place that we require everyone to adhere to:

- 1. On arrival at Wingrove School site please wear a mask or visor and report to the main school reception. Please note, there is only 1 person/family/bubble allowed in the foyer at a time
- 2. Once in the foyer, please press the bell for attention and use the hand sanitiser provided
- 3. A member of the Admin Staff will ask to check your ID
- 4. You will be asked to complete a screening questionnaire (questions below) and asked to sign and date it (you may wish to bring your own pen)
- 5. You will be escorted to your work area you will be required to wear a mask or visor when working 1:1 with pupils or small groups or if you cannot maintain safe distance
- 6. Toilets are available and sanitising products provided
- 7. Refreshments are available, and appropriate measures are in place for people to make themselves a drink safely
- 8. Please adhere to Covid safety information signs regarding number of people allowed in rooms etc.
- 9. Antibacterial spray, cleaning wipes, hand sanitiser and hand washing facilities are freely available throughout the school. Please ask a staff member if there is anything you need
- 10. Please wear a mask or visor when exiting the building and ensure that a member of staff signs you out.

Screening Questions

- 1. Has anyone who lives in your house been diagnosed with coronavirus in the last 10 days?
- 2. Have you or has anyone in your household been advised to self-isolate because you have coronavirus symptoms?
- 3. Have you been advised to self-isolate because you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for coronavirus?
- 4. Are you or is anyone in your household suffering from flu, high temperature, new continuous cough or loss or change of sense of smell or taste?
- 5. Have you been advised to self-isolate because you have entered the UK in the last 10 days?
- 6. Have you been advised to shield because you are at high risk from coronavirus (clinically extremely vulnerable)?
