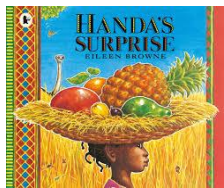

## What we will explore through the reading:

Through our reading we will learn about different sentence structures, which will support our writing. We will use the predictability of familiar texts to write our own sentences and stories. Through non-fiction texts, we will learn about recounts and write our own fact files.

## This term we will be learning:

**English:** We will be learning to read words with phase 3 and 4 phonic sounds. We will be reading and writing sentences, using our phonic knowledge. We will be learning the features of a good sentence and reading and writing tricky words.

**Mathematics:** We will be reading, writing, ordering and understanding numbers to 20. We will be counting objects accurately and identifying one more and one less than numbers. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes.

**Science:** We will be learning about the five senses and identifying and naming common animals. We will also be sorting materials and learning about their properties.
