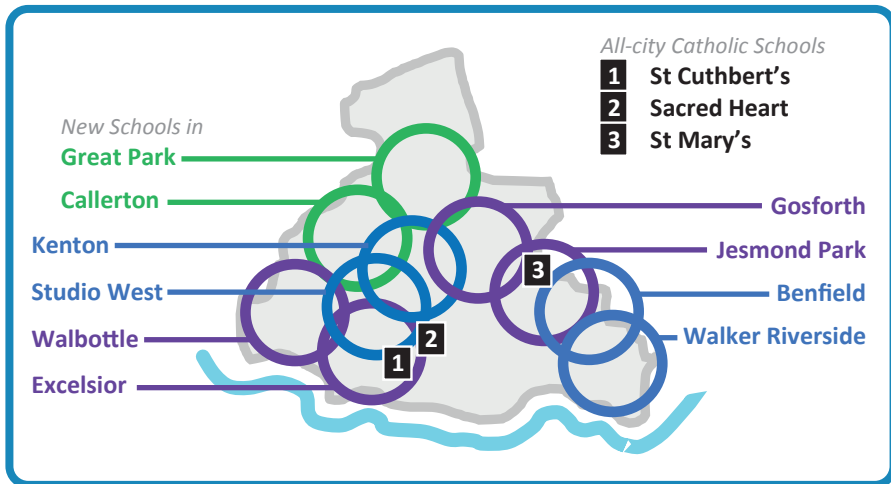

# There are NO Secondary School places in the Inner West



Because the Inner West children live farthest away from the above Secondary Schools, they have to **travel the farthest, leave home the earliest** and **return home the latest** of all Newcastle children.

And so, St Paul's is proposing to open:

**112 new Year 7 places**

in SEPTEMBER 2023

growing every year until Years 7-11 are full with:

**560 Secondary students**

by SEPTEMBER 2027

Compared to the averages for England, the North East, and for Newcastle itself, Inner West parents also have by far the **worst chance** of securing their first choice of Secondary school.

St Paul's wants to offer these **560** new Secondary places in the Inner West, close to our Primary school.

By doing this, we aim to reverse the fact that **94** Inner West children did not get a place in **any** of their Preferences in 2021, **more than double** the figure for those living in the other parts of the city.

Our Proposal is for St Paul's to become an all-through school from Nursery to Year 11, with our own 30+ Year 6 children moving automatically into Year 7 in **September 2023**.

The additional 80 places would be prioritised for **those living nearest the school**.

Although we are a Church of England school, **children of all faiths or none are welcome**.

We are looking at a variety of possible Secondary sites in the Inner West with the Council, Department for Education and private landowners. We plan to keep our current site in Victoria Street as well.
