Communication/Language – To listen to stories. To build up our vocabulary. To understand instructions. To sing songs and join in with rhymes. To begin to share our thoughts.

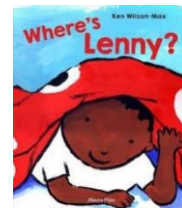

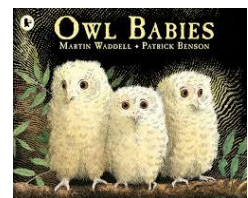
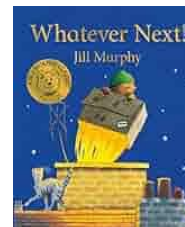

Homework
